Dr. Plummer is a Senior Advisor to the Public Health of Canada. He trained in infectious diseases, and spent 17 years in Nairobi heading the world-renowned Manitoba Nairobi collaboration. From 2000-2014 he was Scientific Director of the National Microbiology Laboratory in Winnipeg. Dr. Plummer is recognized internationally for his work in public health science, with >390 high impact articles.



Lewis Cantley PhD

2015 Canada Gairdner International Award Recipient Professor of Cancer Biology in Medicine, Weill Cornell Medicine, New York Cancer researcher Lewis Cantley, Ph.D., is famed for his discovery of the signaling pathway phosphoinositide 3-kinase (PI3K) in 1984. The graduate of West Virginia Wesleyan College and Cornell University has been a professor at Tufts University and Harvard University, and is currently Meyer Director of the Sandra and Edward Meyer Cancer Center at Weill Cornell Medicine.
